BIRDHOUSE ATTACHMENT

DIRECTIONS



STEP 1: Tape a piece of parchment paper to your work station. Add two pieces sticky side up and tape the sides. This will hold the cutouts in place.



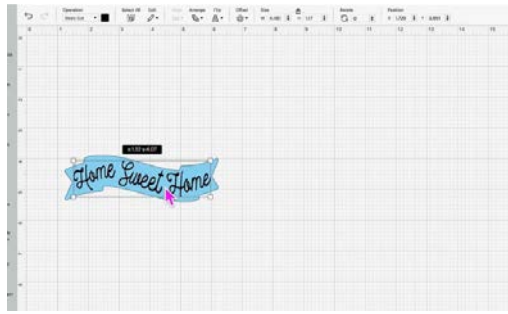
STEP 2: Stick the cutouts to the tape. Mix the paints together to make the periwinkle color and paint everything except the birds and the half triangle.



STEP 3: Paint the remaining pieces yellow. Allow them to dry between coats. I painted the sm. wing berry just for a pop of color.



STEP 4: Add a little brown paint to the end of a popsicle stick and go around the edges of the pieces just to add dimension.



STEP 5: Upload the files to Design Space. Change the banner so it has a width of 5. Resize the words as needed. Then select the words and click attach. Delete the banner. Click Make it.



STEP 6: Load the vinyl onto the mat with the shiny side facing up. Then cut it out.



STEP 7: Weed the design, leaving only what you want to transfer to the cutout.



STEP 8: Place the weeded design face down on the sticky side of the transfer tape. Apply pressure with the scraper, then peel off the paper backing.



STEP 9: Center the design on the cutout. Apply pressure. Start at one corner and gently pull off the transfer tape.

STEP 10: Hot glue the birdhouse pieces together, glueing the yellow piece last.



STEP 11: Hot glue the wood slice to the wreath. Then glue to house to the wood slice.



STEP 12: Loop the floral wire through the hanging side and twist to attach it to the wreath.



STEP 13: Hot glue the knob to the door. Then attach the wire to the wreath by looping it around.



STEP 14: Glue the wing onto the bird, then to the house. Add the moss at the bottom, then glue the flower and greenery.
